This workshop, co-hosted by the Department of Water Resources (DWR) and the California Emergency Management Agency (Cal EMA), will offer assistance to local government agencies interested in developing a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan (LHMP) and demonstrate common goals between the LHMP and other planning initiatives such as General Plans, new water legislation (AB162, AB156, SB70, SB5, and SB17), National Flood Insurance Program – Community Rating System (NFIP-CRS) and California Wildfire Protection Program (CWPP).

The workshop will include presentations from CalEMA, Department of Water Resources (DWR), Office of Planning and Research (OPR), Housing and Community Development (HCD), FEMA-Insurance Services Office/CRS Specialist, and CalFIRE.
